

Ringgold County Board of Supervisors Minutes May 30, 2019

The Ringgold County Board of Supervisors met in special session Thursday, May 30, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Kraig Pennington, Ron Landphair, and Lyle Minnick. Also present were EMA Director Mel Burton and Paul Dykstra.

A motion was made by Lyle Minnick and seconded by Kraig Pennington to approve the agenda. AYES: Unanimous. NAYS: None.

The Board met with Tony Miller from Ottumwa Fire Dept and representing Southeast Iowa Response Group. He discussed the need for extra funding to purchase a new truck. SIRG currently has 2 hazmat trucks with high mileage. There is an opportunity to purchase a new truck for \$70,000 that would hold all the equipment needed. Ringgold's portion would be \$3,900. Once the new purchase is made, the income from selling the other trucks would be applied to the cost of the truck. Payment would not be required until after July 1 and is payable over 3 years. The board will table discussion until there is an opportunity to review the handout materials provided.

The Board met with Sheriff Rob Haley and Civil Clerk Liz Mederos at 9:30. Sheriff Haley presented 2 sealed bids for the former K9 Chevy Tahoe unit. Tanner Rinehart had the winning bid at \$6,755.99. Rob Graham submitted a bid of \$5,867.

Civil Clerk Mederos presented the 3rd quarter (Jan-Mar) financial report of collected fees for the Sheriff Department.

Sheriff Haley discussed the need for parking lot, downspout, and sidewalk repairs, and also interior flooring needs of the Sheriff Office. The board suggested having Interim Engineer Don Staley also take a look and offer suggestions Monday if time allowed.

At 10:20 am Lyle Minnick excused himself.

Sheriff Haley will contact Bill Schaefer to start tiling work. Schaefer submitted an estimate for \$1800 for the needed tiling needed before parking lot repairs could begin.

Sheriff Haley then reviewed needs for upgrading radios and cameras in deputies' trucks. Estimated costs would be \$5,300 per radio and a \$5,000 for a camera. The board discussed purchasing 2 radios now and 3 radios and a camera later next budget year.

Sheriff Haley said he has had 4 interviews for the position of dispatcher/jailer. He hopes to have a candidate selected in the next couple of weeks.
