

Ringgold County Board of Supervisors Minutes October 28, 2019

The Ringgold County Board of Supervisors met in regular session Monday, October 28, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M by Kraig Pennington with the following members present: Ron Landphair and Lyle Minnick.

A motion was made by Minnick, second by Landphair to approve the agenda.
AYES: Unanimous NAYS: None

Assistant to the Engineer Justin Frost met with the Board to provide secondary roads updates. The Board reviewed and approved utility permits presented by Frost. The total patcher finished up for the season working on the lake road North of Mount Ayr. The total patcher was cleaned and put away for the winter. Mowers have been working on paved roads, Frost said. Mowers have also been working up in the Northeast part of the county and will begin to make their way west along J23. One mower has been down in the Southwest working on gravel roads as well.

The remainder of the Farm-to-Market rock was hauled to the North Central territory. Spot rock was then hauled to mud/potential mud holes. It is anticipated to haul spot rock to bad spots for another couple weeks then begin to limit the amount of rock hauled due to oncoming winter.

The crew worked on getting bridge postings updated for special haul vehicles (SHV's). These postings are at the legal limits for straight trucks, semis and doubles, however, restrict the dump trucks with multiple cheater axles. Previously these trucks were only permitted on the primary roadway system, however, last July law was passed that now permits these kinds of trucks to haul construction materials on the secondary roads system.

The crew replaced a rusted out 24" CMP with new 24" ADS culvert on 105th Street in Union Twp. Erosion was encroaching into the roadway at the outlet due to severe elevation difference between the inlet and outlet. A stepped riprap letdown structure was constructed out the outlet to control the velocity of the water running down to natural flow line. The crew is in the process of realigning channel with culvert inlets and repairing erosion to roadway embankment on P64 between 242nd street and 250th street.

Last week the crew was able to get the guardrail ends installed, grout the panel keyways and complete the majority of the site grading on the Liberty 19 bridge project. Riprap was hauled and placed armoring the abutment embankments and channel slopes. The crew also built a sheet pile weir downstream of the bridge to stop stream degradation from that point upstream. This is important as the bridge is a fixed length and as the channel continues to degrade the channel width gets wider. If that was allowed to continue it could potentially cause severe problems to the integrity of the bridge before the end of the repair's useful life. This bridge is scheduled to be complete by the end of

this week, Frost said. Once the concrete is cured, the bridge will be open. They anticipate this to be done within 3 weeks.

The Board tabled approval of the Weed Commissioner report.

Pennington excused himself at 10:40 a.m.
