

Ringgold County Board of Supervisors Minutes April 13, 2020

The Ringgold County Board of Supervisors met in regular session Monday, April 13, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M with the following members present: Kraig Pennington, Lyle Minnick and Ron Landphair.

A motion was made by Pennington, second by Minnick to approve the agenda.

Assistant Engineer Jared Johnson met with the Board to provide secondary roads updates. Johnson reported he has been in coordination with utility companies about relocations in preparation of the 240th street upgrade project.

The majority of the crew hauled spot rock last week, Johnson said. Rock was hauled to the Southwest, South Central, Southeast, and Northeast territories. Spot rock was finished being hauled to the Southwest territory. Rock will continue to be hauled this week, he added.

The patcher was out Thursday and Friday of last week. The P27 (south) and J55 stretches of roadway were completed.

Located on 120th Ave. near 280th Street, work order 596 is now complete. Existing, is an 84" x 50'-0 structural plate culvert with concrete drop outlet headwall. The bottom of the structure had corroded through and developed a void under the pipe near the outlet. Overall, the structure was in fair/good condition other than the floor. The void under the culvert was filled with gravel and the floor was grouted. Riprap was placed at the inlet and grouted in place.

The department submitted notice to bidders for the NRCS EWP project, Johnson said.

The department finished determining the ROW needs for the Washington 20 project. Johnson said it is planned to coordinate with the adjacent landowners this week to schedule a time to discuss the proposed ROW needs for the project. The department will continue developing the plan set this week.

The total quantity of pavement markings was finished being tabulated. The department contacted several pavement marking companies for quotes on the project. They are waiting on quotes to be returned, Johnson said.

Johnson presented the Board with a quote from Denco for a crack filling project on the following roads: P46 for \$39,990; J55 east of P64 for \$28,735; P27 north of highway 2 to J23 for \$79,838. The Board moved forward with approval of each quote individually.

The Board viewed a demonstration via Zoom of an agenda management application with TownCloud. They will discuss further and make a determination of acceptance at a later meeting.

The Board met with Duane Schafer of Southwest Iowa REC via phone to discuss their use of the Pictometry program. The Board stated they would like to share the program with them at no charge due to the age of the imagery. The Board suggested they can work with the Assessor's office to obtain the data they need.

Auditor Amanda Waske presented the Board with a liquor permit renewal for Ramsey Farms. They moved forward with approval.

The Board reviewed claims that were processed the week of April 6th.

The Board reviewed the insurance renewal for FY21. The Board moved forward with the vision renewal with Avesis and the health renewal with Wellmark. The Board tabled the dental renewal as additional research is needed.
