

Ringgold County Board of Supervisors Minutes
September 26, 2018

The Ringgold County Board of Supervisors met in regular session Wednesday, September 26, 2018. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. with the following members present: Kraig Pennington and Paul Dykstra.

A motion was made by Paul Dykstra and seconded by Lyle Minnick to approve the agenda.
AYES: Unanimous. NAYS: None.

Road Superintendent Rod Shields met with the Board to discuss the 110th street project, also known as the Livingston road. Also present: Vera Haley. Shields stated he has been onsite to assess what needs done. He has met with the road grader for the territory as well. The Board realizes there are other projects that are ahead of this and have asked that for now, rock be placed so construction of the Livingston's house can continue. Then, within the next couple of years, the upgrade of the road can take place. It was noted, the Livingston's will pay for the placement of rock once the road is scheduled to be upgraded. Shields stated the department requires something in writing, specifying intentions. The Board will work with the Livingston's to get this document so progress may continue.
